### Planning permission granted for remedial and development works to North Harbour Cape Clear Island

Cailín Óir Ferry Service has welcomed the recent news that planning permission has conditionally been granted for the proposed remedial works in North Harbour on Cape Clear Island to replace the Bull's Nose Breakwater and provide for a new slip and other works.

All resident islanders and indeed a great many visitors to and friends of the Island are only too well aware of the dangerous condition of the Bulls Nose and the possibility of its imminent collapse due to undermining by tidal action. This would, at the least, severely restrict access to
